Student Outcomes

- Graduation rate outperforms both the district and the state.
- Reading, Math & Science outperforms the state and Albuquerque Public Schools.

Mission-Specific Goals

- Both Mission-Specific goals met in all but one year of their contract term.
- School described the challenges due to the pandemic.

Educational Program

- Committed to providing students a mixed-age PBL model with SEL focus.
- Dual Credit classes are conducted on campus for 50-students through IAIA and CNM.

Sustainability Narrative

- Pandemic challenges were specific to this school because of the difficulty in conducting an arts education online.
- Plan includes temporary cuts and re-organizing of staff with the head administrator dropping from 1 FTE to .6 to save costs during this difficult time.

Financial Compliance

- Experienced a 27% drop in enrollment from the beginning of the contract term.
- Two factors supported New Mexico public schools during this time:
 - 1) NM 2021 HB2 Hold Harmless and
 - 2) Federal COVID Relief.

Governance Responsibilities

- Received a Does Not Meet rating on Annual Reports for the first two years.
- Earned a Meets for the most recent two years.

Equity and Identity

- Leadership and staff have started to analyze subgroup reports (Ethnicities, SPED, ELL, FRLP) for data analysis in Equity.
- *The Beauty Way* visual representation has yet to be explicitly presented to students.
